### What Parents Need to Know

- The tutoring that we provide is free of charge.
- Our volunteers are committed to giving 1 hour a week.
- Parents are responsible for providing any needed materials for tutoring
- Though we have rolling admissions, those who sign up during the first week of the semester have the best chance of matching up successfully
- BYU students are asked to tutor in a public place on campus to ensure propriety. Please do not ask volunteer to come to your home.
- We will give your contact info to the BYU student and they will contact you to schedule a time that works for both parties
- It normally takes about a week to find the right tutor for your child
- Our tutors are not professionally trained, but are qualified for their subjects
